Bibliography of Simmel's Writings in English Translation

Below is a comprehensive list of all Simmel's writings currently available in English translation. They are listed in chronological order according to the date of publication or composition in Simmel's lifetime, using the best available information provided by the editors of the *Georg Simmel Gesamtausgabe* (GSG). Dates of composition of posthumously published works are in square brackets. Note that some works appeared in more than one version in Simmel's lifetime; that several translations appear in several sources; and that parts of works appear in several translations, such as *The Philosophy of Money* (1900/1907), *Sociology* (1908), and *View of Life* (1918). Many of Simmel's essays remain untranslated, and there are no complete translations of his letters, writings on pedagogy, and the monographs *On Social Differentiation*, *Introduction to Moral Science*, *Main Problems of Philosophy*, and *Goethe*. Note that GSG 18 includes English translations published in Simmel's lifetime, many of which appeared in the *American Journal of Sociology*. Translations available in issues of *Theory, Culture & Society* (print and online) are indicated using the abbreviation TCS. The following edited anthologies are also cited in the chronology:
